ACA members only may advertise in the Trading Post. The first ten lines (Sells/Wants) are free. Additional lines are \$5.00 (U.S.) each. Payment and ads must be received by the 15th day of even numbered months. *The next deadline is Tuesday February 15th, 2000.*

HOW TO SEND YOUR AD:

RULES FOR SELLERS:

- (1) Your name, address, and shipping instructions have to fit on two lines.
 - (2) Only cichlid species and books may be listed.
 - (3) You must use the scientific name of your fish and if possible give a photo reference or state the collecting location. Place trade names and color forms in parentheses after the scientific name; add "AS" for Aquarium Strains.
 - (4) Up to two morphs per line, but only one size and price per line.
- NOTE: The Trading Post will not list known hybrids (e.g. red parrot cichlid, OB and "hybrid" peacocks, *Cichlasoma* sp. "ebano"). Aquarium developed fin shape and color mutants are allowed. The editor reserves the right to standardize names and determine whether a fish is a true species, color form, or hybrid. His decisions can be overruled by the BOT.
