Pulp from the Primary Predator:

And here it is, my last issue. Thanks to Scott Saunders, Karen Haas, and Sean Furney for volunteering to help. After careful consideration, the BOT awarded the prestigious honor of being the TP editor to....John Iszczyszyn! John is currently the editor of JAWS, the trading post of the Greater Chicago Cichlid Association. Three years was enough for me, though no record by any means (the Bennis managed 10 years).

My parting gift to you, the loyal ACA member, is the ability to list any species in TP for \$10 a line. If it is not a cichlid, it costs you \$10 even if it is your only line. The time has come for cichlid keepers to have access to dither fish like tetras and rainbows, and scavengers like albino plecos, and even the Tanganyikan killifish. Still no hybrids, or bizarre fish that do not express the essence of a cichlid. We are going to try this for a while and see how loud the screaming gets. Change is good remember. Keeps the organization vital.

Everyone wants a legacy. Initially I lead the change to 5 sells for free, 5 wants for free, as was the policy when I joined the ACA in 1980. This lasted a year maybe, and it went back to 10 sells for free. I removed the species list that Jan Benn had prepared by hand since I was not smart enough to figure out how to get the database to do it for me. The screaming from that died down. I also tried to get the real Malawi trash, hybrid peacocks, out of TP. I succeeded for a while, but eventually lost the peacock wars, as I call them. If I had my way, only wild type cichlids would be allowed in TP. But you won't have me to kick around anymore.
