RULES FOR SELLERS:

- (1) Your name, address, and shipping instructions have to fit on two lines.
 - (2) You must use the scientific name of your fish and if possible give a photo reference or state the collecting location. Place trade names and color forms in parentheses after the scientific name.
 - (3) Up to two color morphs per line, but only one size and price per line.
