- (3) Up to two color morphs per line, but only one size and price per line.

ACA Cichlid Conservation Policies for the Trading Post

In 2004 a proposal was approved by the ACA BOT to promote endangered cichlids in the ACA Trading Post. A list of 154 cichlid species can be found at the IUCN's redlist.org. After the webpage comes up then do a search for cichlidae and the list will appear. These cichlids have been evaluated by scientists and it has been determined that these species are either extinct, extinct in the wild, critically endangered, endangered, vulnerable, near threatened or data deficient. In order to promote the propagation of these cichlids, Trading Post will allow free lines in the TP to ACA members to advertise the sale or want of these cichlids. Currently ACA members are allowed a total of ten lines for free with additional lines costing \$5 per additional line. Cichlids on this red list placed in Trading Post will not be charged the \$5 fee if additional lines are required. This will cover all the Lake Victorian, Malagasy and Cameroon Lake cichlids as well as some Central American and South African species. If there are any questions about cichlids on the red list they should be directed to Charles.Rambo@urscorp.com. The ACA hopes its membership will review this list and make an effort to obtain and propagate these species for future ACA members.

The job of the Layout Editor moves beyond simply placing text and photos, to creating maps, choosing cover photos, and creating special effects. The ACA is looking for a creative person, with an eye for detail. The Layout Editor must be someone who enjoys being a part of the team effort. Dedication to the ACA is essential, as 40 hours per issue may be required, and deadlines must take precedence.
