All transactions between buyers and sellers from ads in Trading Post are at member's risk. Buyers are urged to obtain a photo reference and full scientific name from seller. Trade names are allowed, but may be made up by collectors, importers, wholesalers, retailers and breeders. Listings that lack a photo reference, and/or include a color in the description, or end in "AS" (Aquarium Strain), may be hybrids between two species.

ADVICE FOR SELLERS:

- (1) Your name, address, and shipping instructions have to fit on two lines. No other messages are allowed. Only cichlid species and books may be listed.
- (2) Use the full scientific name on your species listing and give a photo reference. If a photo reference is unavailable, give the collection location, and restrict the use of trade names and color. Append "AS" for Aquarium Strains.
- (3) While the Trading Post will not list known crosses (e.g. red parrot cichlid, OB peacock, Cichlasoma sp. "ebano"), aquarium developed fin shape and color mutants are allowed, provided the seller appends the name with "AS".
- (4) Up to two morphs per line, but only one size and price per line.
- (5) The editor reserves the right to change advertisements and make errors. The goal of the Trading Post is to sell fish, however the editor will strive to standardize names, for the sake of buyers, whenever possible.

Pulp from the Primary Predator:

Oh boy, a whole page of white space to fill up.

Thank you to all who voted in the election. Your new BOT members are Wayne Leibel and myself. Kathy Stearns and Pat Tosie return for another term, while Chuck Rambo, Joe Sprinkle, and Ken Davis finish their current terms this year. Lee Ann Clary has resigned, and the BOT has filled her position with Rich Bireley. I would like to thank Todd Fleishans for his work on the BOT and for the Publicity and Sales Committees. I am sure he will be busy with next summer's convention in Detroit.

Has the heyday of cichlids come and gone? I read recently in Aquaculture Magazine that Florida last year for the first time in a while sold more livebearers than cichlids. However, in my fishroom, I haven't seen any livebearers eating cichlids yet. Here in Eugene, population 140,000 and somewhat isolated, the manager of a local store told me today not to bring her any more African cichlids, not even any sheldwellers, something I had never asked her to take before today. She says only a handful of customers, mainly college aged men, even ask about them, and they rarely buy, preferring instead to trade among themselves. Worse, these customers come in asking her to buy cichlids from them, though they never buy anything. Sound familiar? Am I talking about you?

Our local club is stagnating, with a small core that is failing to attract and retain new members. Worse, I don't know who these college aged cichlid keepers are. They might be interested in the ACA, if I could find them. The ACA membership is down to 1447, including some 200 lifetime members. The 1200 who are left paying support what services we provide, mainly TP and BB. If membership drops anymore, we will not be able to afford a color BB. Go out and find those young cichlidiots!

I am looking forward to a trip to Motor City. I have heard that the Belle Isle Aquarium is on the tour list. While not as big as the Shedd in Chicago, the Belle Isle Aquarium is the oldest continuously running public aquarium in America, and boasts some unique architectural elements that rival the Shedd's Victorian appearance. Formerly run by James Langhammer, it is now curated by Doug Sweet. Doug participates in the Victorian Cichlid Breeding Program, and swaps fish a lot with Jay Hemdahl at the Toledo Zoo.

A bus tour is scheduled for Friday to the aquarium, where the tour will be broken into small groups for a behind the scenes look at how the aquarium functions. Also included will be a look at the Conservatory which is right next door. After that, the whole group is off to Greek Town for lunch, and then back to the hotel for Friday evening's speakers. 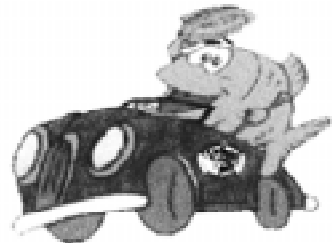
