ACA members only may advertise in the Trading Post. The first ten Sells and/or Wants are free. Additional lines are \$5.00 (U.S.) each. Payment and ads must be received by the 15th day of even numbered months. *The next deadline is Thursday, April 15th, 1999.*

HOW TO SEND YOUR AD:

ADVICE FOR BUYERS: Caveat Emptor! The American Cichlid Association is not responsible for the advertisements contained in this publication. All transactions between buyers and sellers from ads in Trading Post are at member's risk. Buyers are urged to obtain a photo reference and full scientific name from seller. Trade names are allowed, but may be made up by collectors, importers, wholesalers, retailers and breeders. Listings that lack a photo reference, and/or include a color in the description, or end in "AS" (Aquarium Strain), may be hybrids between two species.

ADVICE FOR SELLERS:

- (1) Your name, address, and shipping instructions have to fit on two lines. No other messages are allowed. Only cichlid species and books may be listed.
- (2) Use the full scientific name on your species listing and give a photo reference. If a photo reference is unavailable, give the collection location, and restrict the use of trade names and color. Append "AS" for Aquarium Strains.
- (3) While the Trading Post will not list known crosses (e.g. red parrot cichlid, OB peacock, Cichlasoma sp. "ebano"), aquarium developed fin shape and color mutants are allowed, provided the seller appends the name with "AS".
- (4) Up to two morphs per line, but only one size and price per line.
- (5) The editor reserves the right to change advertisements and make errors. The goal of the Trading Post is to sell fish, however the editor will strive to standardize names, for the sake of buyers, whenever possible.

Pulp from the Primary Predator:

The ACA is doing well but needs your support to continue providing the services you want. Three people sent me ads this month whose memberships had expired. The ACA needs you (and your friends). Ask your cichlid buddies if they are a member; get them to join. And write an article for BB. Dave always needs help.

I have changed my email address. It is now **ehanneman@uswest.net**. I will keep my old address until April 15th, the next TP deadline, and then it is history.

There is still a password required for the member's only area on the web site. I have printed it below (see page 15 bottom).

You all know my penchant for using the latest fish names, and I know that sometimes new names make familiar fish hard to sell. As editor, I spend a fair amount of time not just entering data and formatting TP, but also looking up fish names, not just to see if the name has changed, but also to see if the name is spelled correctly. I figure that I do the readers a service by this educational endeavor. Some advertisers do a great job of formatting their ads correctly, including a photo reference, alphabetizing their listings, and avoiding changes in things like shipping instructions. You know who you are and I appreciate it.

Others can barely write legibly, much less spell. Worse, they think a common name is all that is needed. Unfortunately, common names vary around the country: same name, different fish, or same fish, different name.

For the sake of fairness, I have started to think that the style of a seller's ad may actually represent something significant about the seller and their stock. So in the future, if I get a handwritten, barely legible, list of common names, I might just print it that way. That way, I do not have to do the work for you.

And now, it's pet peeve time again! 1) Cichlidiots who change their shipping instructions every time. 2) Cichlidiots who try to cram 4 lines of information onto their allotted 2 lines, even though I have to delete it every time. 3) Cichlidiots who insist on placing more than one size per line. 4) Cichlidiots who use the new name one month and change back to the old name the next time. 5) Cichlidiots who use common names or abbreviate the genus so I can guess what fish they really have. 6) Cichlidiots who complain but never do anything. Have I left anyone out?

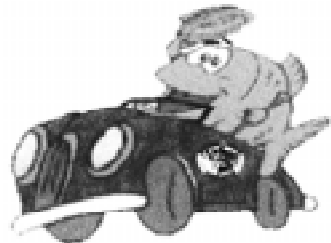
