All transactions between buyers and sellers from ads in Trading Post are at member's risk. Buyers are urged to obtain a photo reference and full scientific name from seller. Trade names are allowed, but may be made up by collectors, importers, wholesalers, retailers and breeders. Listings that lack a photo reference, and/or include a color in the description, or end in "AS" (Aquarium Strain), may be hybrids between two species.

ADVICE FOR SELLERS:

- (1) Your name, address, and shipping instructions have to fit on two lines. No other messages are allowed. Only cichlid species and books may be listed.
- (2) Use the full scientific name on your species listing and give a photo reference. If a photo reference is unavailable, give the collection location, and restrict the use of trade names and color. Append "AS" for Aquarium Strains.
- (3) While the Trading Post will not list known hybrids (e.g. red parrot cichlid, OB and "red" peacocks, Cichlasoma sp. "ebano"), aquarium developed fin shape and color mutants are allowed, provided the seller appends the name with "AS".
- (4) Up to two morphs per line, but only one size and price per line.
- (5) The editor reserves the right to change advertisements and make errors. The goal of the Trading Post is to sell fish, however the editor will strive to standardize names, for the sake of buyers, whenever possible.

Pulp from the Primary Predator,

“If anyone sends me any peacock names without a species in the future I will NOT list them; or if I gather more consensus at the convention that the imports are just as much hybrids as the gross OB peacock, they will not be allowed in TP either.” I threatened this last issue and now it has come true. The BOT authorized me to remove all hybrid peacock listings from the TP.

I have seen the turquoise peacock and it is definitely a hybrid. In Detroit there was a tank of *Aulonocara* sp. “red” (no species name given as usual). The tank contained three males, one blue, one yellow, and one red. I assume it is the same whether the hybrids are called *rubescens*, red, red *rebensis*, *rubensis*, red albino, red jake, *Haplochromis jacobfreibergeri* “red”, German red...come on people!

There is a fish known as *Aulonocara jacobfreibergeri* “Eureka”. This fish is thought to be a cross between two populations of jakes, the Otter Point population and the Domwe Island (=Swallowtail=*carolae*=*reginae*) population. I am sure different populations of these fish have been hybridized before, after all the females are practically indistinguishable. That is why it is essential to know your fish, and to know the lineage of your fish. Buy Ad Konings’ Malawi 2nd edition and his Tanganyika book. They are the ones I use. Buy your breeding stock from a reputable source. Someday we will lose access to the lovely natural variants coming from the wild. If we do not treasure them now, we will be left only with these gross hybrids. If you do not know the lineage of your fish, simply call them *A. stuartgranti* or *A. jacobfreibergeri*. These two types are easily distinguishable. If you buy a Malawi book, you might even find a picture of your fish. Do your fry grow up to look like their parents? If not, you are probably dealing with a hybrid and the stock should be destroyed.

Several of you noted that I published the name *Apistogramma ramerizi* last issue. I sometimes just print things as they come in. This month I spent hours looking things up. I was feeling charitable after some time off, so I corrected all the misspellings that I could, Next time I might not be so kind.
